

Arrival:

Salmonberry's school day begins at 8:45. The window for arrival is 8:45-9:00. Drop off for most students will be drive through style. From North Beach Rd, turn west onto Henry Rd. There will be greeters there to direct you throughout the first week of school. You will turn right through the Senior Center parking lot and then circle around past the Crossroads Cottages before heading back east towards the school entrance. There will be single file vehicle line, which will split into two lanes. Please wait until you have reached the front of one of these two lanes (there will be a painted designated area) when your child may safely hop out of the vehicle and where they will be welcomed by teachers into the school yard.

For parents who would like to get out of their vehicle and accompany their child to the gate, you may park in the Senior Center lot for five minutes and carefully walk your child over. For parents who need a longer window, we have secured permission to park at the St. Francis Catholic Church's lot on the corner of North Beach and Mt. Baker Rd. You may park there and walk across North Beach Rd, and south along the pedestrian path with your child to the school entrance.

For parents of younger children who may have a less successful transition without parents' support, you may accompany your child onto the school grounds. We ask that you are masked and keep your distance from other children.

...**And Departure** will work much the same way. The school day ends at 3:05, and you can pick up your child from 3:05-3:15. You can once again drive through the two lanes on Henry Rd. Kids will be waiting for you in the parking lot. Or you can park off campus and walk over to the gate for pick up.

We hope this will all go smoothly, once we're used to it, and we'll make modifications to this plan if needed. Meantime, thank you for your cooperation and patience while we work out any possible issues during these first couple of weeks.

Construction: Salmonberry's former south parking lot is now an active construction zone. Our classroom building is scheduled to arrive on September 21, with occupancy a few weeks later. Until then, there are some hazards to be aware of. There are piles of dirt and rock, a huge hole in the ground and heavy equipment moving in and out. This part of the yard will be fenced off and the hazards will be clearly identified. It might be a good time to review some basic safety rules with your child(ren.)
