

Job Announcement January 2024

Position: Elementary Classroom Teacher, 4th grade

Application Window: Apply by May 10, 2024 or until position is filled

Qualifications: Salmonberry School is seeking a caring, fun, mature teacher with experience teaching primary grades. A qualified applicant would hold a BA or higher and have at least 3 years experience as a lead teacher with children under age 12 in a school or similar environment. Particular expertise in teaching literacy is valued. The candidate should have some knowledge and/or experience in progressive or holistic education. Excellent communication skills are essential as are strong organizational skills and an ability to coalesce a classroom community of students and parents. The ideal candidate should also model a willingness to learn and an excitement to grow as a member of the highly collaborative faculty team.

Duties: This is a lead teaching position. Duties include all aspects of curriculum development and implementation, assessment, communication, classroom design and classroom management for 10-15 students ages 8 to 10 years old. In future years, this position may include 3rd-5th graders The teacher must engage all learners in a wide span of skill levels and learning styles and incorporate all aspects of a holistic approach to learning. They must embody an ethic of care in all aspects of the work. A full or part-time teaching assistant will be provided depending on enrollment and classroom needs.

Approach to Teaching: The candidate should be excited to develop a program that emphasizes:

- excellent and balanced academics and an ability to integrate purchased curriculum and self-generated activities
- differentiated instruction, tailoring experiences to a range of interests and learning styles
- student choice, cultivating autonomy and self-direction in students
- cooperative and collaborative learning
- experiential and hands-on learning including field trips
- integrated arts
- focus on SEL as an integral component to the program
- mindfulness and centering curriculum

Dates: Position begins on or about August 25, 2024 and will follow Salmonberry's academic calendar. The position may be renewed on a yearly basis. The expected commitment is a minimum of three years.

Hours: This is a salaried position. Student contact hours are 8:45-3:05 M-F. Expected work week is 35-40 hrs. This includes required staff meetings once/wk as well as special events, festivals and field trips.

Compensation: This is a full-time position for a traditional academic calendar year. Salary is \$45,000 - \$65,000, depending on experience, and includes 10 paid leave days. Additional summer work is also available outside of this contracted position. Teachers receive full medical benefits including 100% premium payments on a silver level health plan.
